



Our Building Recycles

Acceptable Materials

Place these items in your recycling container.



Paper and Cardboard

Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, envelopes, office paper, cereal boxes, cardboard boxes, and molded pulp egg containers.



Plastic

Plastic bottles and containers (coded # 1 through # 7, **except #6 Polystyrene**). Includes soda and water bottles, milk jugs, shampoo bottles, detergent containers, reusable water bottles, and squeezable ketchup and mustard bottles.



Metal

Tin, steel and aluminum cans; aluminum foil, trays, pots, pans and utensils.



Glass

Bottles and jars. All colors acceptable. Label need not be removed.

Unacceptable Items

The following items should NOT be placed in with the single stream recycling container.

- Motor oil, insecticide, herbicide or hazardous chemical containers
- Plastic bags (return bags to grocery or department store)
- Plastic film (no plastic sheets, tarps or wrap)
- Expanded foam or clear polystyrene

All other waste should be placed in the appropriate waste container.

Additional Information

- Individual recycling bins available for purchase from Building Management.
- All recyclable items may be placed in the same recycling container.
- Empty bottles and cans before recycling.
- Place all other waste in your garbage container.
- Waste & recycling are picked up separately.
- The building recycling program is in compliance with the City of Chicago Residential Recycling Ordinance.
- The building waste and recycling program is serviced by Premier Waste and Recycling
